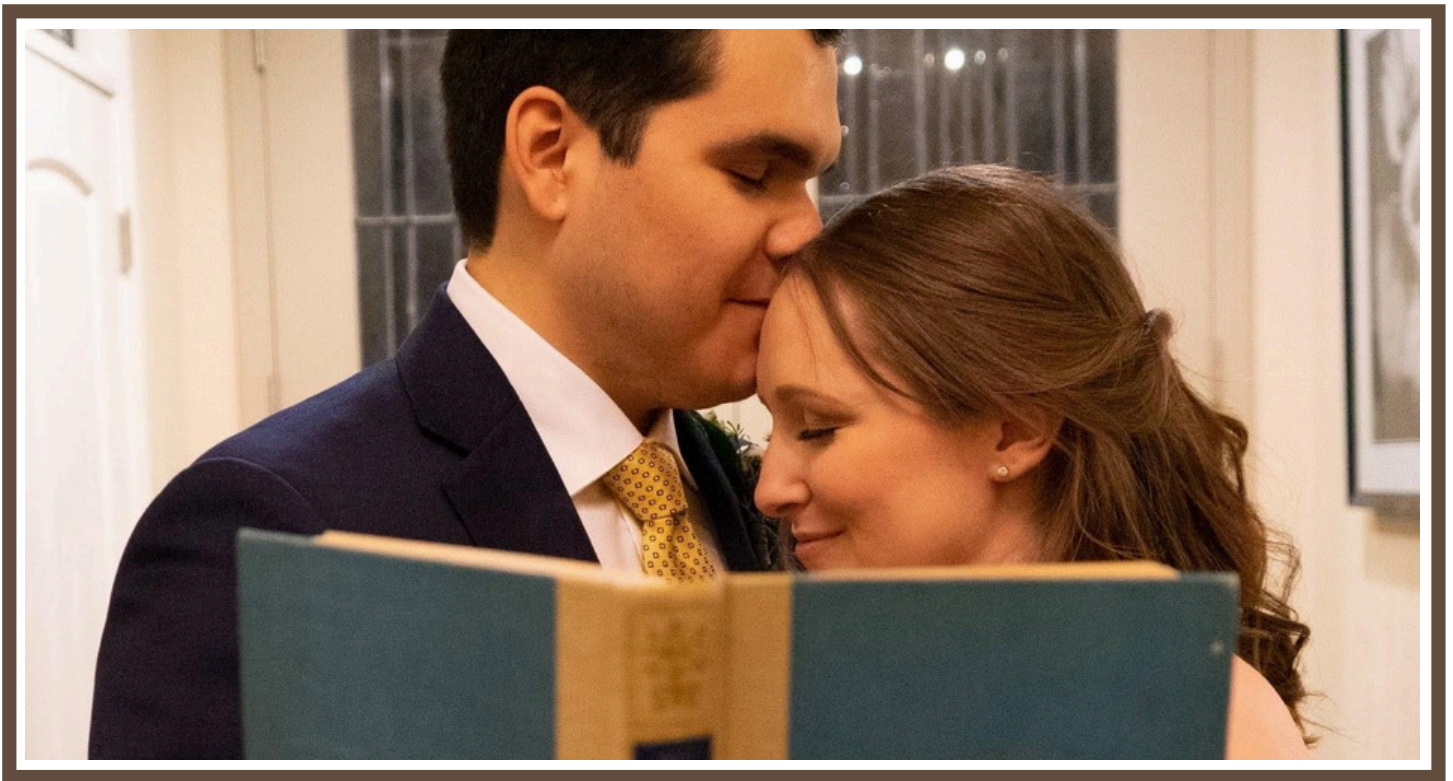


We are thankful to you for choosing this path and considering us.

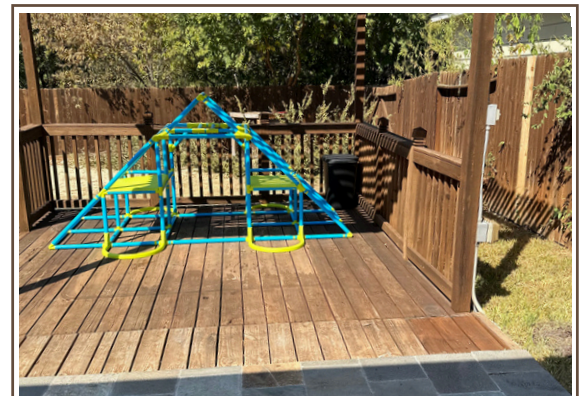

Our Home



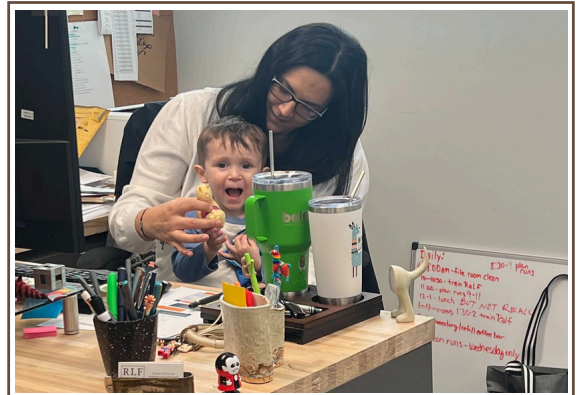
